Important dates and deadlines

Below is a list of key dates for the year ahead. Please take a moment to note these important milestones for prospective Indigenous students who are considering applying to UBC.

September – December 2022	UBC presentations for prospective Indigenous students Geared toward Indigenous students in Grades 11 and 12, these presentations provide information about life on UBC's Vancouver and Okanagan campuses, academic programs, admissions, financial planning, and the resources and services for Indigenous students. Our Indigenous Recruiter Advisors are excited to offer in-person presentations this Fall to a number of areas across the country. If you are interested in having us present to your community or school, either virtually or in person, please contact us.
December 1, 2022	Deadline to apply to UBC for a first-round offer of admission and award consideration Students who apply to UBC by December 1 will be automatically considered for a first-round offer of admission and a Presidential Scholars Award. Students with financial need can submit a separate application to also be considered for a Centennial Scholars Entrance Award. In the incoming class, 22 Indigenous students received a Presidential Scholars Award (6 renewable and 16 one-time awards), and 17 Indigenous students received a Centennial Scholars Entrance Award (16 renewable and 1 one-time award). Awards were valued at \$20,000, \$40,000 or \$80,000.
January 15, 2023	Deadline to apply to UBC
