The responsibilities of this position(s) may include, but are not limited to:

- Performs a variety of tasks in support of survey and or construction activities
- Duties may differ depending on the specialty area
- Activities may include setting up and operating equipment; inspecting equipment; assisting with the building, repair, or maintenance of a structure, roadway or other like construction site
- Relies on general understanding of procedures, company policies, and business practices to plan and accomplish moderate goals
- Works well under direct supervision

Minimum Requirements

- High school diploma or GED equivalent (may be an asset)
- 2+ Years Of relevant experience (would be an asset)
- Must possess a valid driver's license and clean driving record (considered an asset)
- Must pass pre-employment drug screen (may be a requirement)
- Physically able, with or without an accommodation, to work in outdoor environments with uneven terrain, variable outdoor conditions including heat, cold, moist, dry, dust, noise, chemicals, work in confined spaces, repetitive or fine hand movements, and lifting of up 50 pounds; working alone in isolated/remote areas.
- Ability to wear all associated personal protective equipment, including fall, hearing, and respiratory protection as per position
